End-of-Life Care in Canada

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EOL in Canada – the numbers...

- 260,000 deaths in 2016 (0.7% of population)
- 4.2 million seniors, will double by 2036
- 60% die in acute care facilities, 20% in other health facilities
 - ~15% admitted to ICU during final admission
 - 51% have life-support withdrawn
 - 49% die on life support
 - 3% receive CPR at/near death

EOL in Canada – the numbers

Location of Death

- 58% die in hospital
 - 15% have PC admission
- 20% die in long-term care
- 15% die at home

- **Location of Care**
- 62% hospitalized in final year of life
 - Mean 32 days
- 37% hospitalized in final month
 - Mean 14 days

Palliative Care in Canada

- PCU admissions in Toronto
 - 79% Cancer
 - 4.5% "Heart Disease"
 - 3.1% Dementia
 - 2.2% "Respiratory Disease"
- Inpatient PC consultation in Canada
 - 70-80% Cancer
 - 20-30% noncancer

- Inpatients dying of noncancer vs. cancer
 - Organ failure- 5x less likely to get PC
 - Frailty- 10x less likely to get PC

EOL in Canada – MAID


- First 9 months...
 - 1324/195,000 = 0.68%
- Numbers increasing in Ontario
 - July-Dec 2016- 31/month
 - Jan-Jun 2017- 60/month
- Highly variable by region


The 2015 Quality of Death Index Ranking palliative care across the world

Auditor General of Ontario Report on PC (2014)

- "Strategic policy framework not in place"
- "Little...information on the supply of or demand for PEOLC"
- "Access to palliative care services is not equitable"
- "Most publicly funded services used by cancer patients"

EOL in Canada – Wishes and Planning

- Among seriously ill inpatients...
 - 76% have thought about their EOL care
 - 70% would prefer to die at home
 - 12% would want life-prolonging therapy
 - 54% admitted to ICU during final admission
- Relatives of deceased are 17.9 times more likely to be satisfied with EOL care if pt died in preferred location of death

EOL in Canada – Decisions and Disputes

- Shared Decision-Making
- Requests/disputes about non-beneficial treatment
 - Acquiescence
 - Unilateral decision-making by MD
 - Conflict resolution (?)
 - Second opinion
 - Consent and Capacity Board
